

Dear Valued Customer,

We would be happy to assist you in planning your stay with us at the Iwokrama River Lodge. Kindly find our rates, description of tours & options for transport to the Iwokrama's River Lodge provided below:

Option 1:

Overland with Iwokrama's 4x 4, air-conditioned pickup from Georgetown (Iwokrama's Office) to Kurupukari Landing where the Iwokrama River Lodge is located.

The cost of this vehicle is **US\$500 (4 seats) & US\$700 (6 seats)** this is a return cost. The duration

of this trip is approximately 6hrs one way.

Option 2:

Transguyana scheduled flights from Ogle Airstrip (Georgetown) to the Annai Airstrip, where you will be met by Iwokrama's staff to be transferred by 4x4 land cruiser to the Iwokrama Field Station. You will incur a **US\$220 cost.** (Transfer fee).

The duration of the flight is approximately an hour and a return ticket costs **235 usd per person** (once booked four week days before; after that period the cost will be **265 usd per person**. Tickets can be arranged with the Tourism Office at the Iwokrama International Centre, 77 High Street, Kingston.



The Rates for one night in a cabin at Iwokrama River lodge is as follows:

- Triple occupancy

- Forest User fee US\$15(Per person)
- Meals US\$39(per person; breakfast ,lunch & dinner)

The Forest user fee is a one-time charge for anyone overnighting in Iwokrama's Rainforest.

Terms and Conditions

RESERVATIONS

- **1.** All requests for provisional or confirmed reservations are to be made by the Guest by way of letter, facsimile, voucher or e-mail addressed to Iwokrama River Lodge.
- **2.** No reservation will be deemed confirmed unless acknowledged and accepted in writing by Iwokrama River Lodge. The lodge will respond to all reservation applications in a timely manner and will reply using the same medium of communication whereby the request was made.
- **3.** Provisional reservations will be held for 7 days, if a deposit is not made to confirm the reservation, the booking will be automatically released.
- 4. The reserving party must furnish Iwokrama River Lodge with the following information:
 - Guest's last name and full first names.
 - Number and category of rooms required.
 - Preferred arrival and departure dates.
 - Arrival and departure points and information (airline, charter or transfer information).
 - Nationality of Guests.

PAYMENT PROCEDURE

Payment of each reservation charge shall be made as follows:

A non-refundable 20% deposit upon acceptance of reservations is to be received by Iwokrama River Lodge from the Guest within seven (7) working days from date of request; failure to provide a deposit will result in the automatic cancellation of the reservation.

The balance is due not less than thirty (30) days prior to arrival.

CANCELLATIONS

Should any reservation or payment provision not be observed by the reserving party, Iwokrama River Lodge will be entitled to cancel the respective reservation with immediate effect. This will be done by way of written notice.

Cancellation Conditions:

Should a cancellation be received between confirmation and 30 days prior to arrival a 10% cancellation will be charged.

Should a cancellation be received between 0 and 29 days prior to arrival a 100% cancellation will be charged.



Cancellation fees are calculated on the rate per person and on the total value of the full stay. All reservation amendments or cancellations are valid only if advised and accepted in writing, facsimile or e-mail.

Iwokrama River Lodge recommends that guests consider a travel insurance policy, which may assist in offsetting any unforeseen cancellation charges.

Iwokrama reserves the right to deduct all expenses incurred from money received.

Transfer of booking: In the event you are unable to come due to extraordinary circumstances, we may transfer your booking to another party provided the arrangements remain the same.

Mode of payment: All prices are quoted in US Dollars, but we accept the local currency. We accept Visa, MasterCard, and American Express as well as travellers cheques.

Transport: Mode of transport utilised will be dependent on the number of clients travelling and participating in activities. All of our vehicles are 4 wheel drive and air conditioned. Fully trained and experienced English speaking driver/guides are provided.

Accommodation: Large groups may have to share accommodation with a maximum of three adults per cabin. Hammock Pods (15us per person per night) are dormitory style so visitors may have to share with people they don't know.

Travel Insurance: You are advised to buy travel insurance through your agent before coming to Guyana.

Liability: Iwokrama reserves the right to employ subcontractors to carry out all or part of the transport agreed to be supplied. The respective laws of the country govern Iwokrama's liability to passengers carried in its own vehicles. All claims are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of the country in which the cause of action arises.

Viewing wildlife: When it comes to wildlife viewing, please be advised there are no guarantees. It is a privilege to see animals in their natural habitats; our experienced guides will take every measure to ensure your experience is enjoyable. The only thing you can kill is time the only thing you can take is a photograph; the only thing you can leave is your footprints. Wildlife viewing is also dependant on the seasons.



What to bring to Iwokrama

- Rubber boots or other waterproof *footwear* (We do not recommend wearing open footwear to walk in the rainforest)
- Long trousers (2), preferably made of cotton-polyester mix.
- Long-sleeved shirt, sweater or jacket for cool evenings
- T-shirts or short-sleeved shirts (3-4); light colours are preferable, darker colours can attract insects
- Several changes of socks
- Raingear poncho or raincoat
- Hat & sun-screen
- Flip flops or trainers to wear when not on activities
- Flashlight (headlamp if you want to see animal eye shine at night)
- Insect repellent
- Swimming costume
- Medication which you may require
- Binoculars
- A water container
- Small Day Pack to take on activities
- Small penknife
- A Camera with flash.
